What is the difference between the Graphite and Composite?

The Graphite paddles are lighter in weight. They range from 6.5 ounces to 7.0 ounces. The Composite range from 7.0 ounces to 8.0 ounces. Many players that enjoy a durable lightweight paddle choose the Graphite paddles. Some feel that the lighter the weight the more control. Also, it reduces strain on joints and muscles since players would not have to over exert themselves while hitting the ball.

Does the size of the paddle really matter?

This is just wasted space and adds more bulk to the paddles. The Slammer and Stryker are designed to use the most control and power in the “sweet spot.”
